

About VLP

VLP Therapeutics, Inc. (VLPT), co-founded in 2013 is a Maryland, US-based biotech company with a mission to address unmet medical needs worldwide and expand the frontiers of vaccine treatment. VLPT is currently engaged in research and development of a cancer treatment vaccine as well as prophylactic vaccines against infectious diseases including influenza, malaria and dengue.



The Situation

With a team of just 20 employees, VLP was gearing up for a Phase I oncology vaccine trial. Like many emerging biotechs, VLP initially believed that with such limited resources, they would need to fully rely on external vendors to run their clinical operations. At the time, their entire clinical operations team consisted of just one person—Clinical Trial Manager, Summer Acevedo. However, Summer had a bold vision: she aimed to streamline their vendor partnerships, keeping them to a minimum, while still maintaining maximum control and oversight of the trial. Her challenge was to find a way to balance these competing goals without overwhelming the company's small bandwidth.



To tackle VLP's ambitious goals, Medidata's Professional Services team partnered with VLP, offering a tailored approach through interactive workshops.
