

Medidata Rave CTMS: Configuring Source Data Review Tracking eLearning

Course Description: The Source Data Review (SDR) Tracking capability in Rave CTMS provides a centralized location to track and streamline the data review process performed by clinical research associates (CRAs) or monitors. In addition, administrators, study managers, CRAs, and monitors can utilize the system to determine the anticipated number of participant visits completed and the corresponding reviews expected within a given period.
